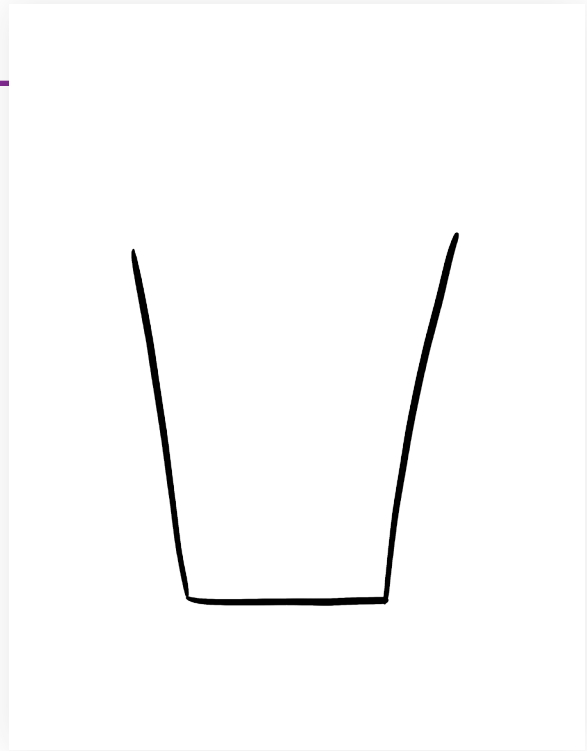
# HAUNTED HOUSE



# How to Draw Haunted House

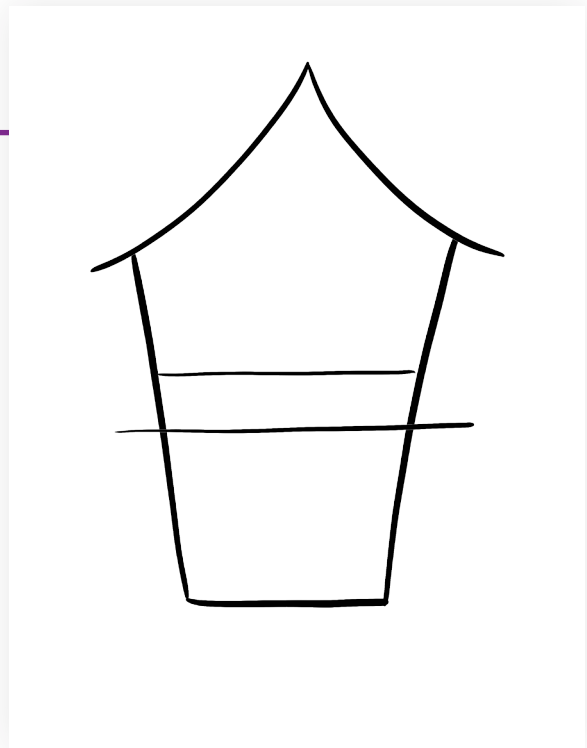
**1**

Begin with a tall and thin trapezoid shape.



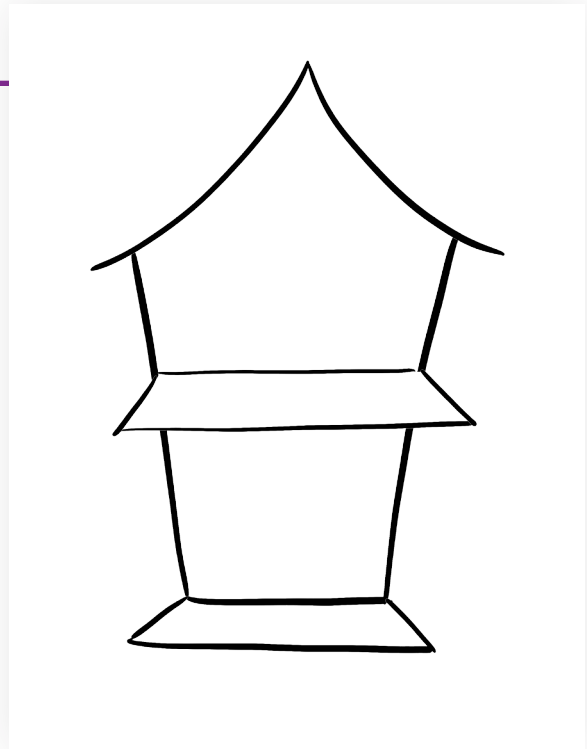
**2**

Add a roof to the top of the building. Add two parallel lines in the middle of the house (the bottom one slightly longer) as the start of the lower roof.



**3**

Connect parallel lines with two diagonal lines to form a trapezoid for the lower roof. Draw another long and skinny trapezoid at the bottom of the house for the porch.



**4**

Add a long and thin rectangle to the front of the porch to create depth, and draw a door and a few windows using simple shapes.



**5**

Add a long and thin rectangle to the lower roof, draw a chimney, add details to window shutters, door and porch. Draw stairs by alternating rectangles and trapezoids that gradually get larger.



**6**

Add horizon line. Draw a straight or curved line and then zig zag on one side if you'd like to draw a cliff.



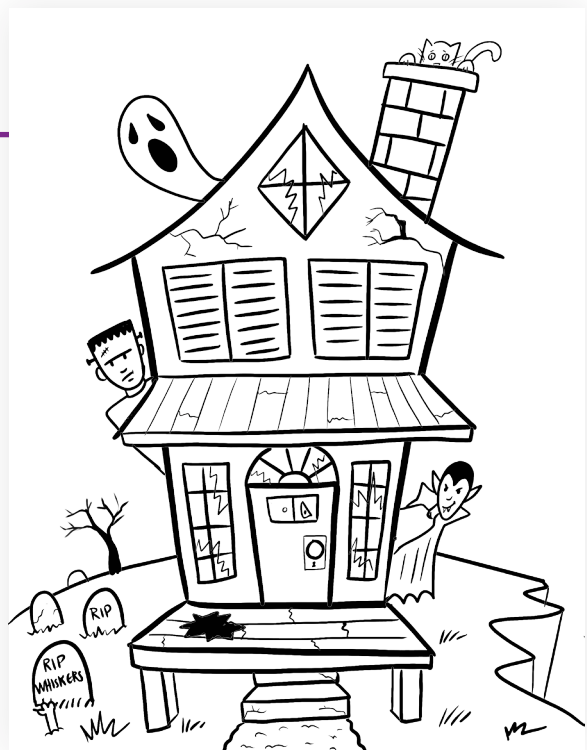
7

Add vertical lines to zig zag cliff lines. Draw details for the haunted grounds around the house. If drawing tombstones, be sure to make the stones get smaller as they go back to horizon line to show depth. All items get smaller as they go back.



8

Add **SPOOKY** characters surrounding the house (See separate drawing guide).





## Bonus Step: Spooky Interactive Windows

With the assistance of an adult, use an X-acto knife to cut along the closed shutters (along the top, bottom and middle line). This will allow the shutters to open. Take a small piece of yellow paper (small 3"x 3"ish size for one window, or 3" x 8" rectangle to cover up both windows, and tape it to the back of the paper.

Now you have a place to draw spooky and maybe funny characters hiding in the haunted house! Be creative with who you would see! Frankenstein and Dracula having a tea party? A ghost singing in the shower? A witch stirring up an eyeball stew? The possibilities are endless!



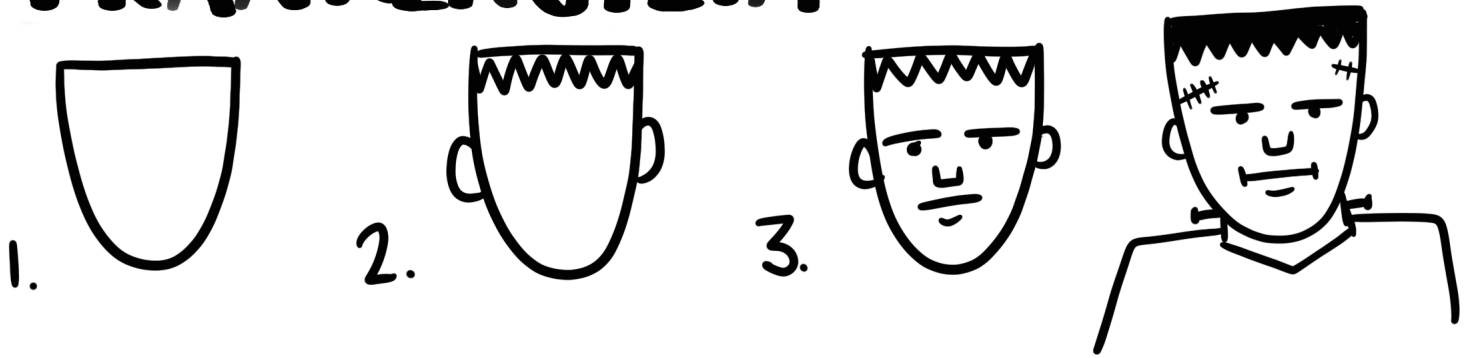
### RECOMMENDED MATERIALS

- Colored pencils.

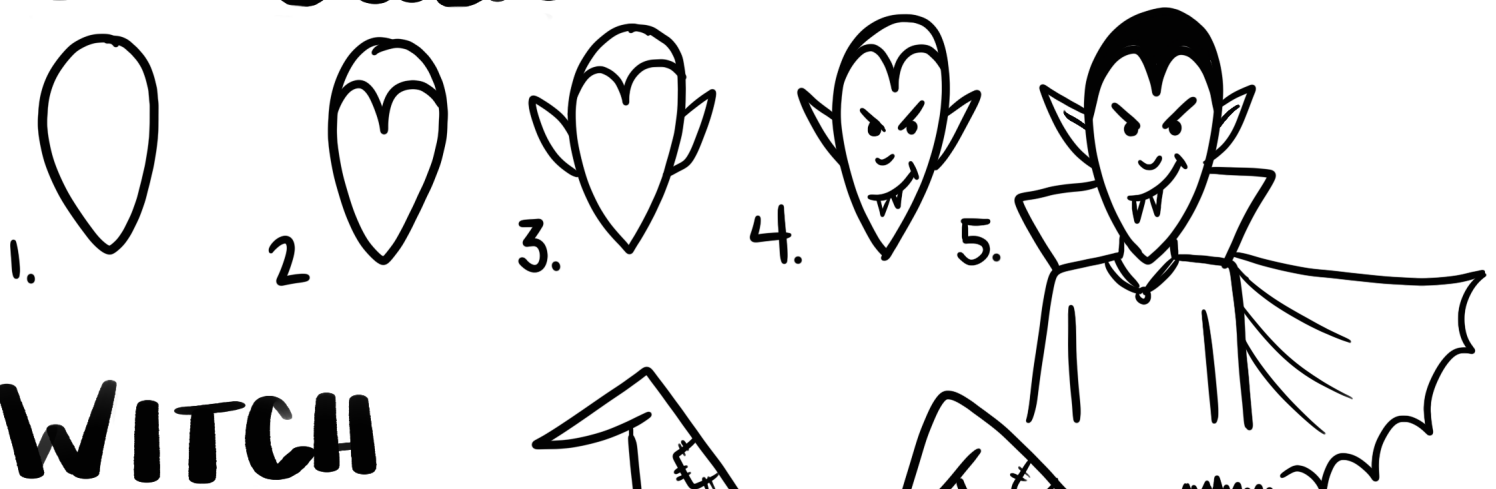
